- 4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender (cash in British pounds only) or by BACS transfer. (Details to be obtained upon request).
- 5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 12 December 2019.
- Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Gloucester Road, Tewkesbury, Glos, GL20 5TT by 12 midnight on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
- 7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes (including postal proxy) must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Gloucester Road, Tewkesbury, Glos, GL20 5TT by 5pm on Tuesday 26 November 2019.
- 8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Gloucester Road, Tewkesbury, Glos, GL20 5TT by 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
- 9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election applied for on the grounds of either physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Council Offices, Gloucester Road, Tewkesbury, Glos, GL20 5TT by 5pm on Thursday 12 December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 4 December 2019.
