

**GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATHS AGO17 & AGO20**  
**(GOTHERINGTON PARISH) TEWKESBURY BOROUGH ORDER 2024**

WHEREAS the Gloucestershire County Council ("the Council") being the Traffic Authority for part of Public Footpaths as defined in the schedule below ("the Footpath") is satisfied that use of the Footpath should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near it.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of its power under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order:

**CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of February Two Thousand and Twenty Four and shall continue in force for a period not exceeding six months and may be cited as "Gloucestershire County Council Temporary Closure of Public Footpath AGO17 & AGO20 (Gotherington Parish) Tewkesbury Borough Order 2024"

**GENERAL**

2. Except for pedestrian access to properties, emergency access and access for the said works no person shall proceed on foot nor cause or permit any person to proceed along the Footpath
3. The Footpath falls in Gotherington Parish in the Tewkesbury Borough in the County of Gloucestershire

**SCHEDULE**

**Part of Public Footpath AGO 17** in the Parish of Gotherington is to be temporarily closed to users under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) in a generally south easterly direction for approximately 20 metres to its junction with AGO 19.

**Part of Public Footpath AGO 20** in the Parish of Gotherington is to be temporarily closed to users under Sections 14, 15 and 16 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) from its junction with Public Footpath AGO 19 in a generally easterly direction for approximately 290 metres to its junction with Public Footpath AGO 18.
