A report had been circulated to Members prior to the meeting. This included research completed by the Clerk and advice from GAPTC. The clerk had also requested clarification from Tewkesbury Borough Councils' CIL officer but she had declined to provide a definite answer. The CIL Officer stated that she had also been contacted by the Chair of the Parish Council on this matter but the Clerk had not been included in this email communication.

On the basis of this report and the information provided, Clerk advised that Council should vote again on the donation to the school, but to defer the item until after the public consultation.
